## Minimum Qualifications:

- Previous or current classroom teaching/coaching experience (or equivalent)
- Excellent written and communication skills.
- Ability to perform moderate computer functions. Proficient in using email, managing files, recording and reporting grades electronically, and using computer applications including word processors, spreadsheets, Internet browsers, and web search engines.
- On-line teaching, or previous experience in teaching online helpful, but not required.
- Teaching experience is helpful, but not required.
